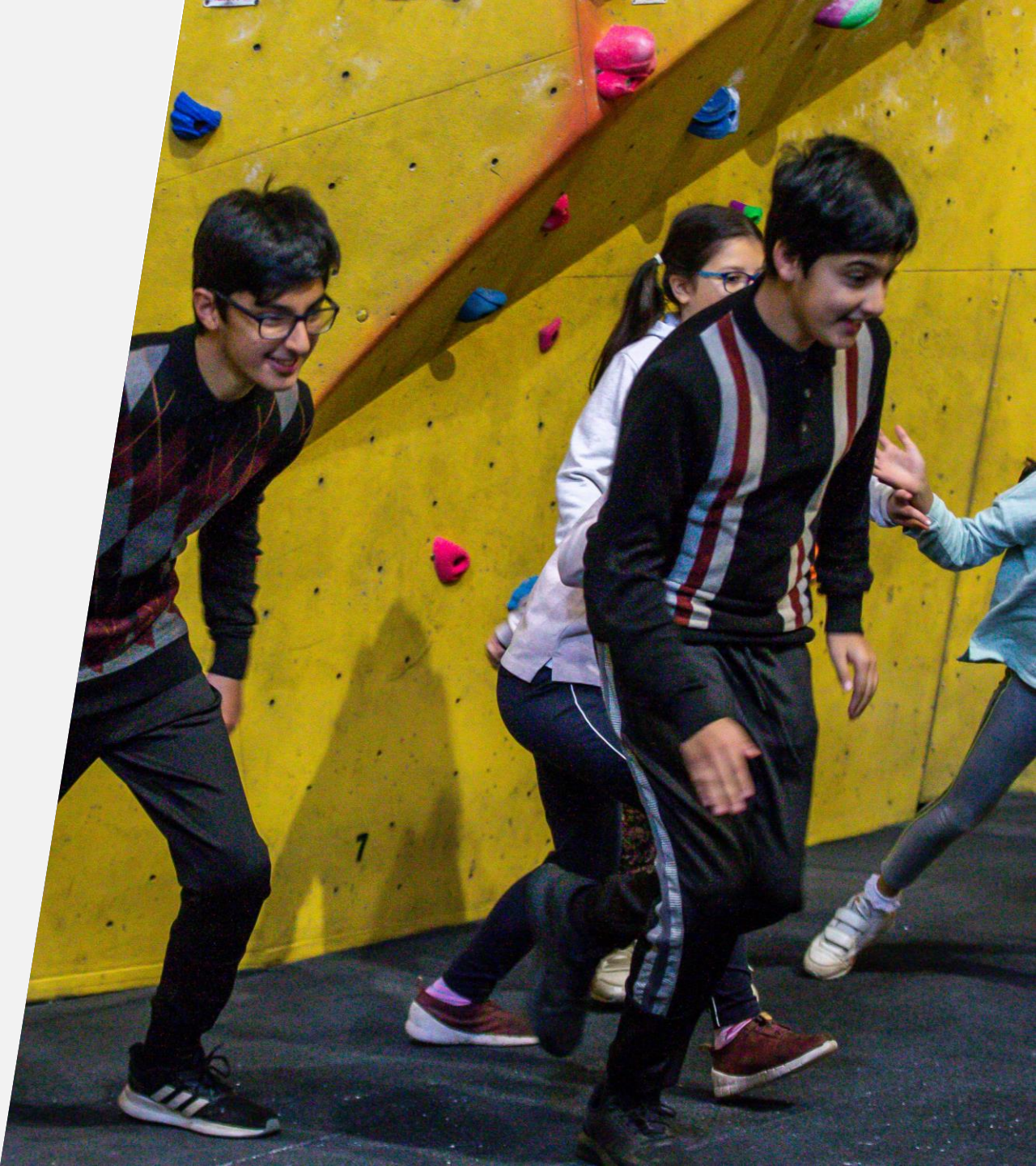

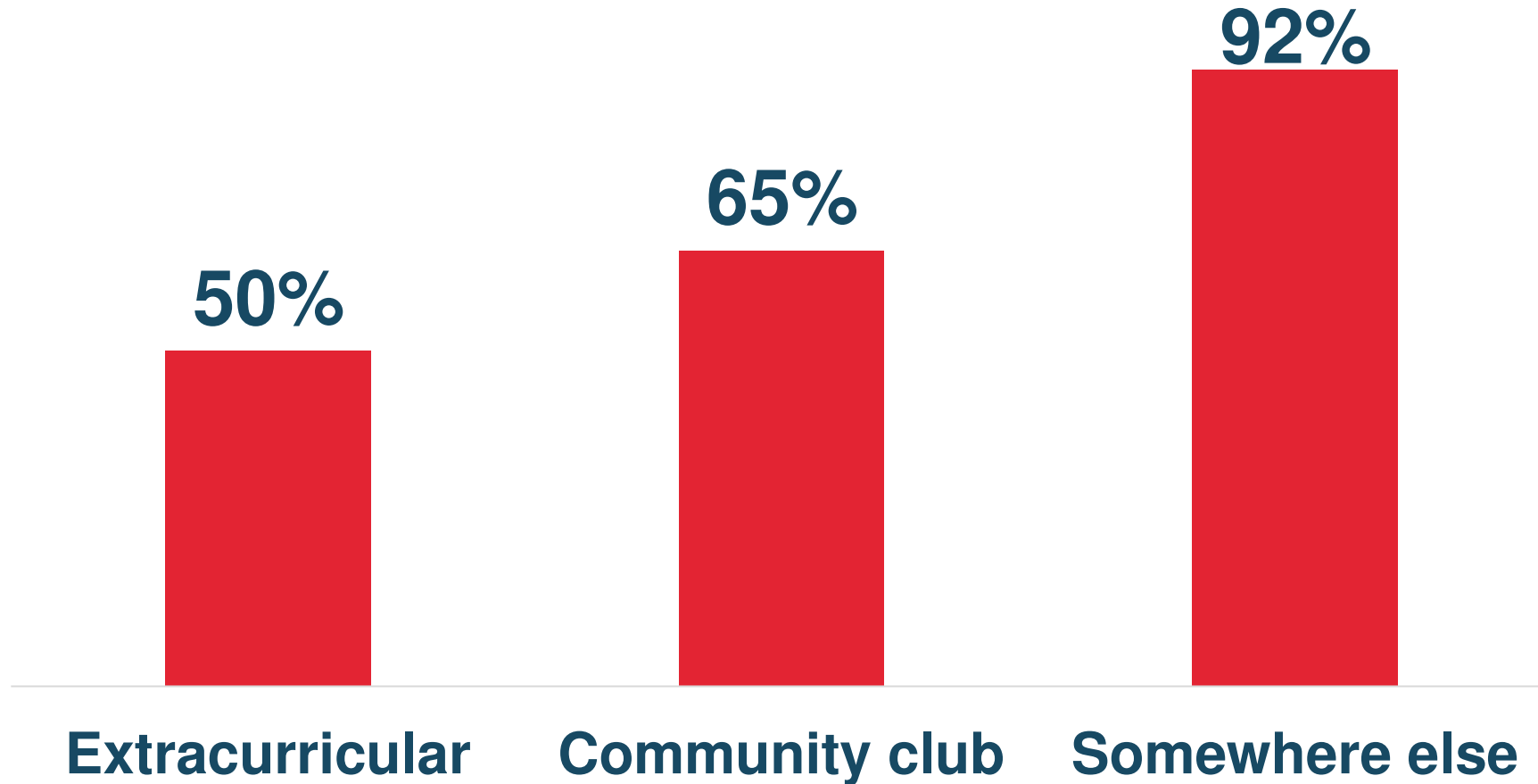

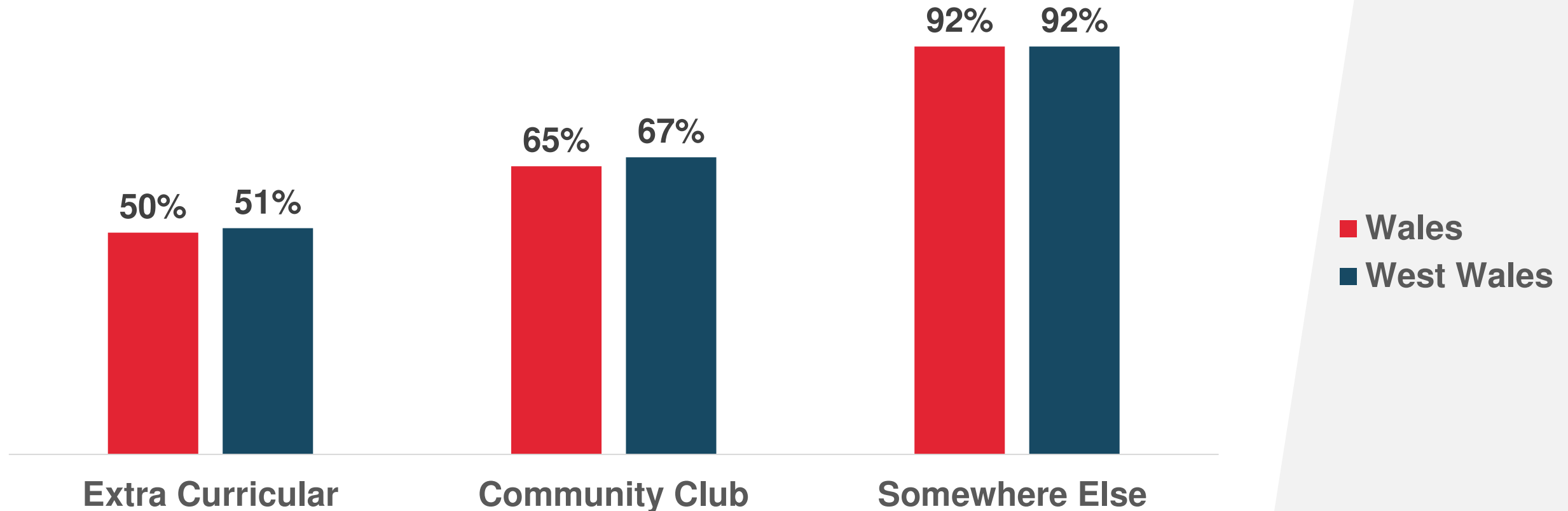

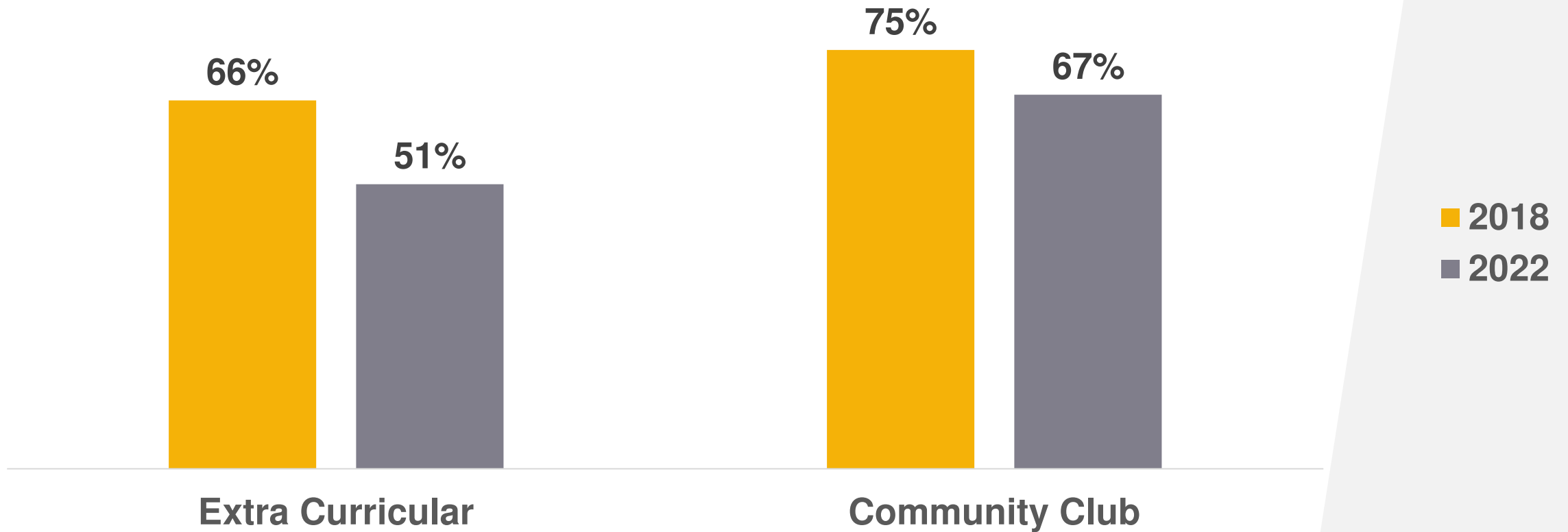
# Any participation by setting (Wales)



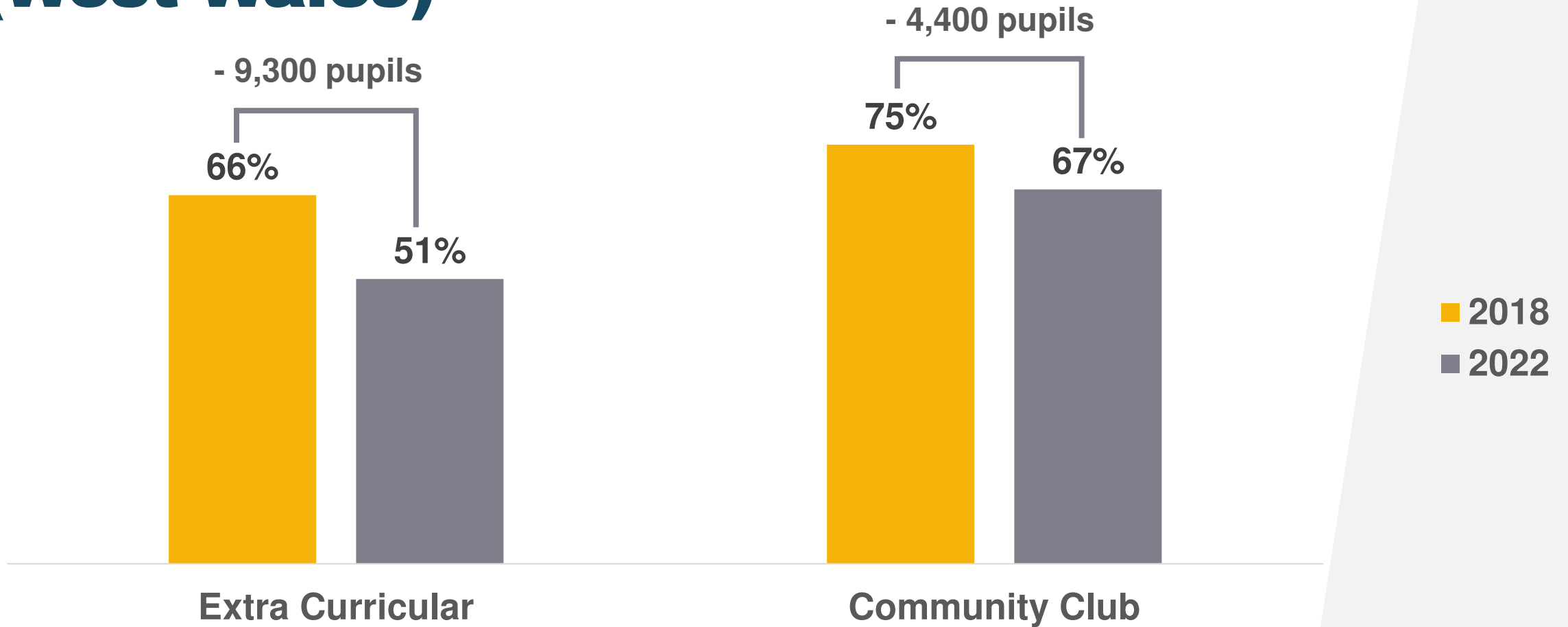
## Any participation by setting (Wales, West Wales)

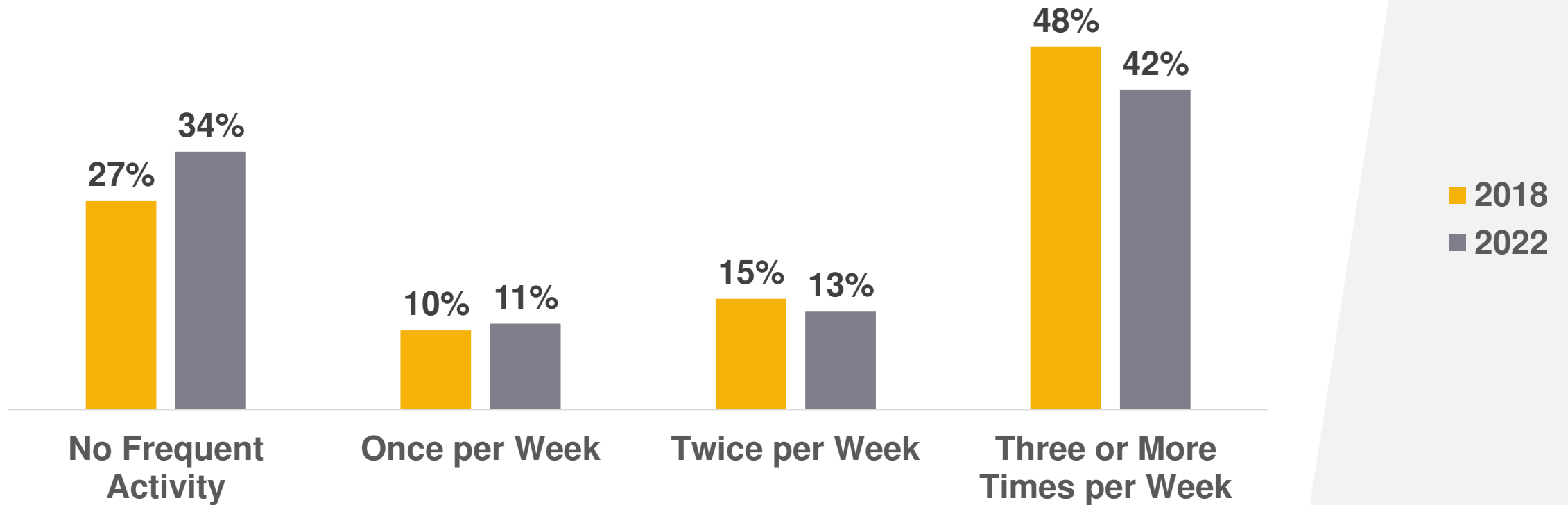

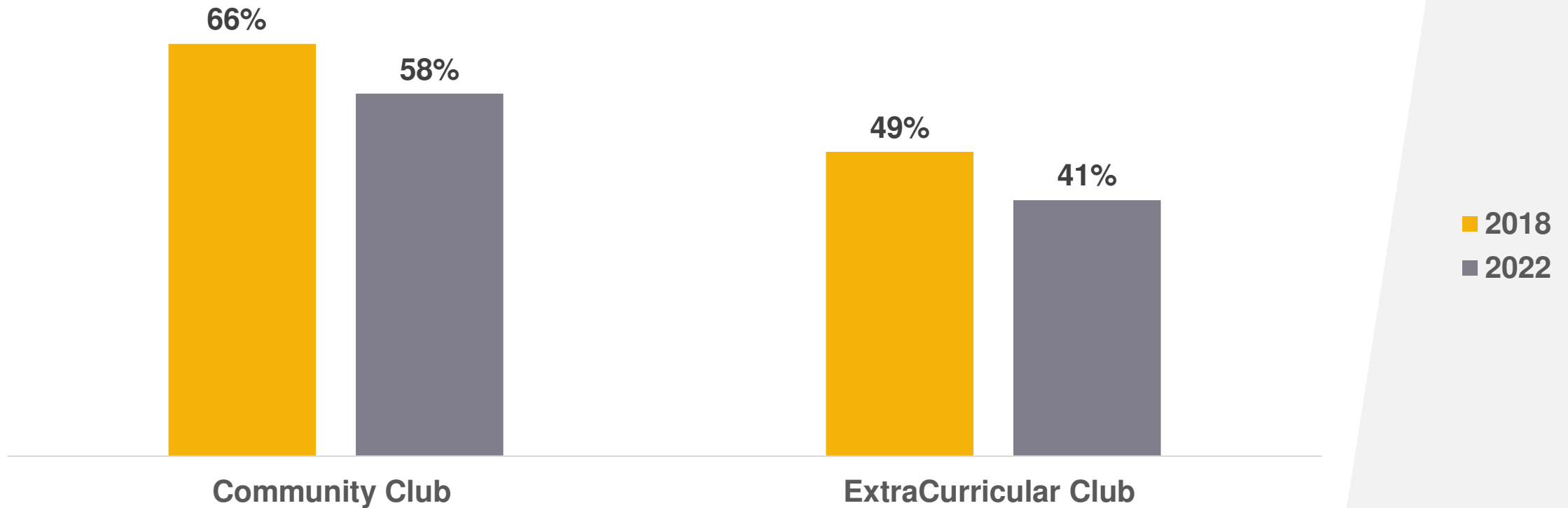

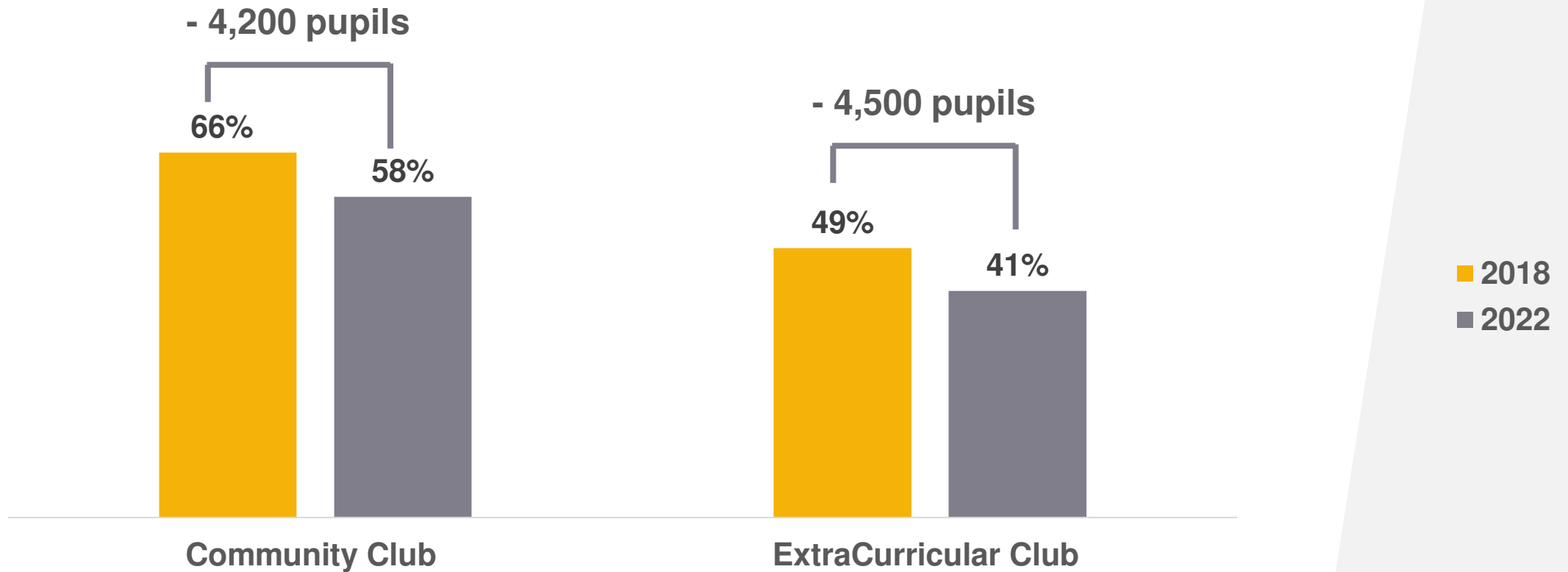

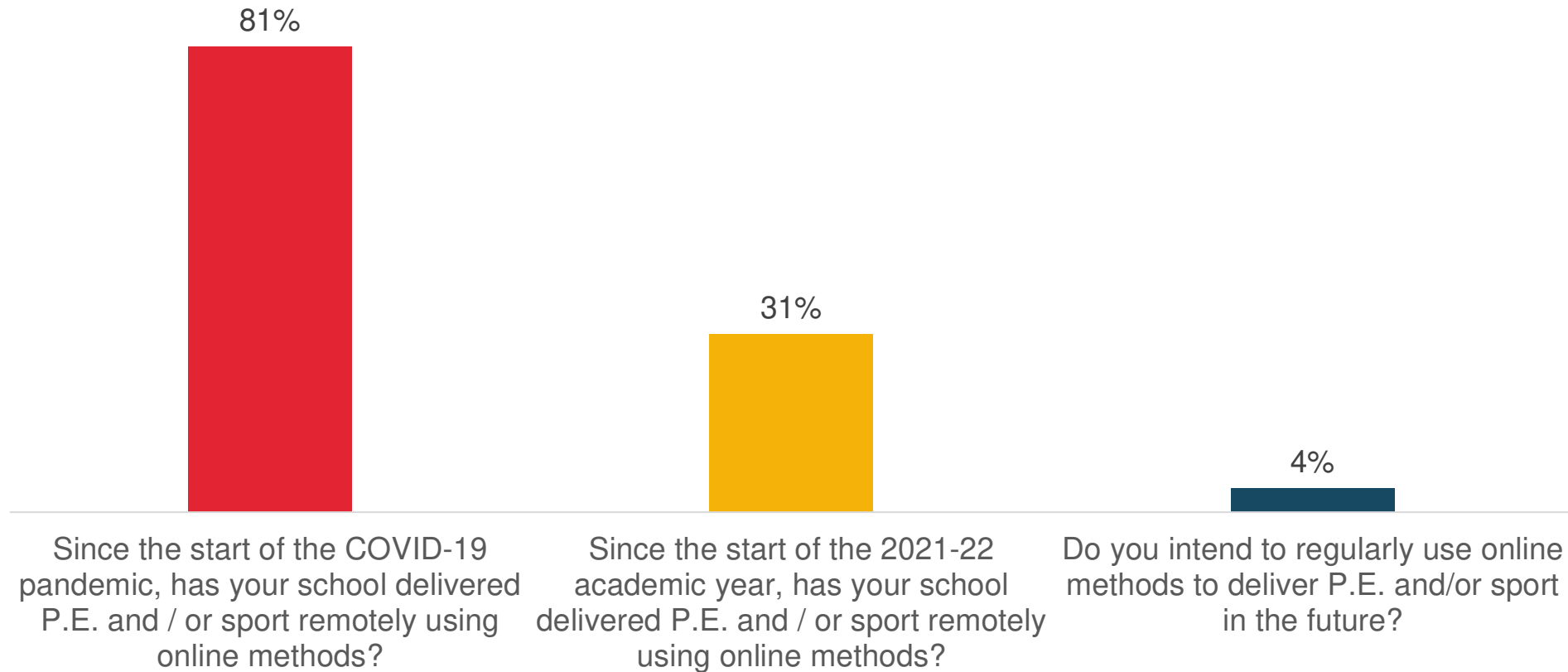

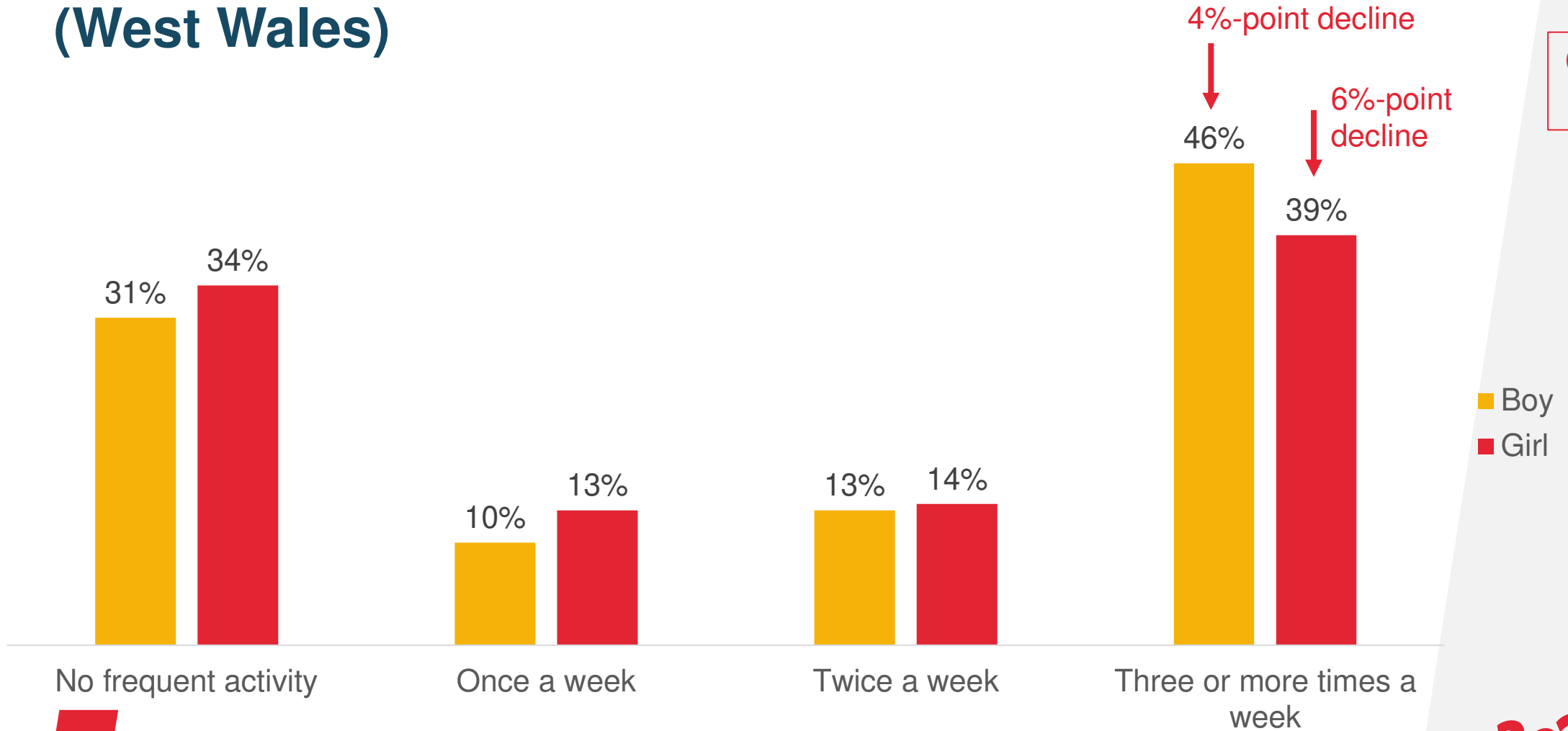

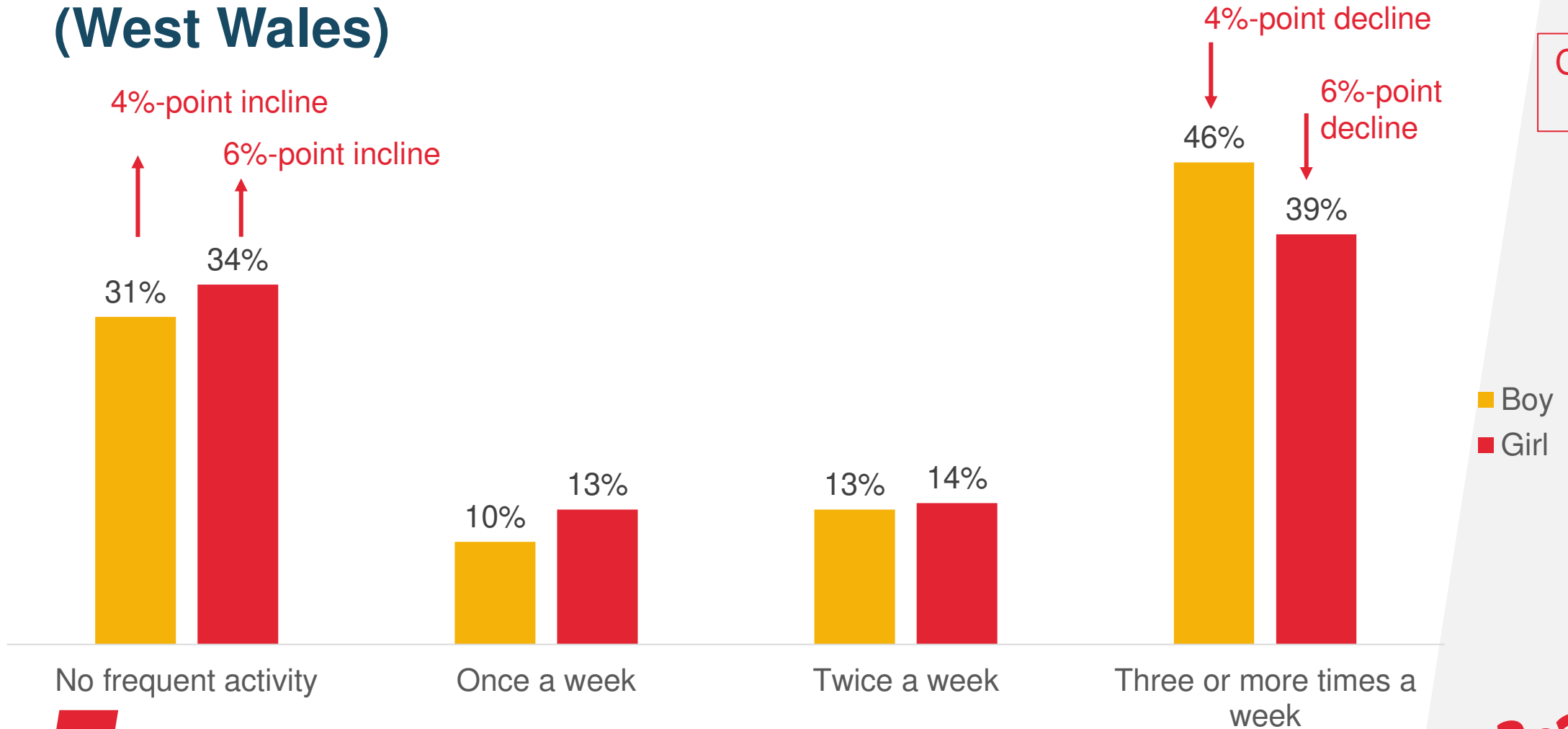
# Gender – Frequency of Participation (West Wales)

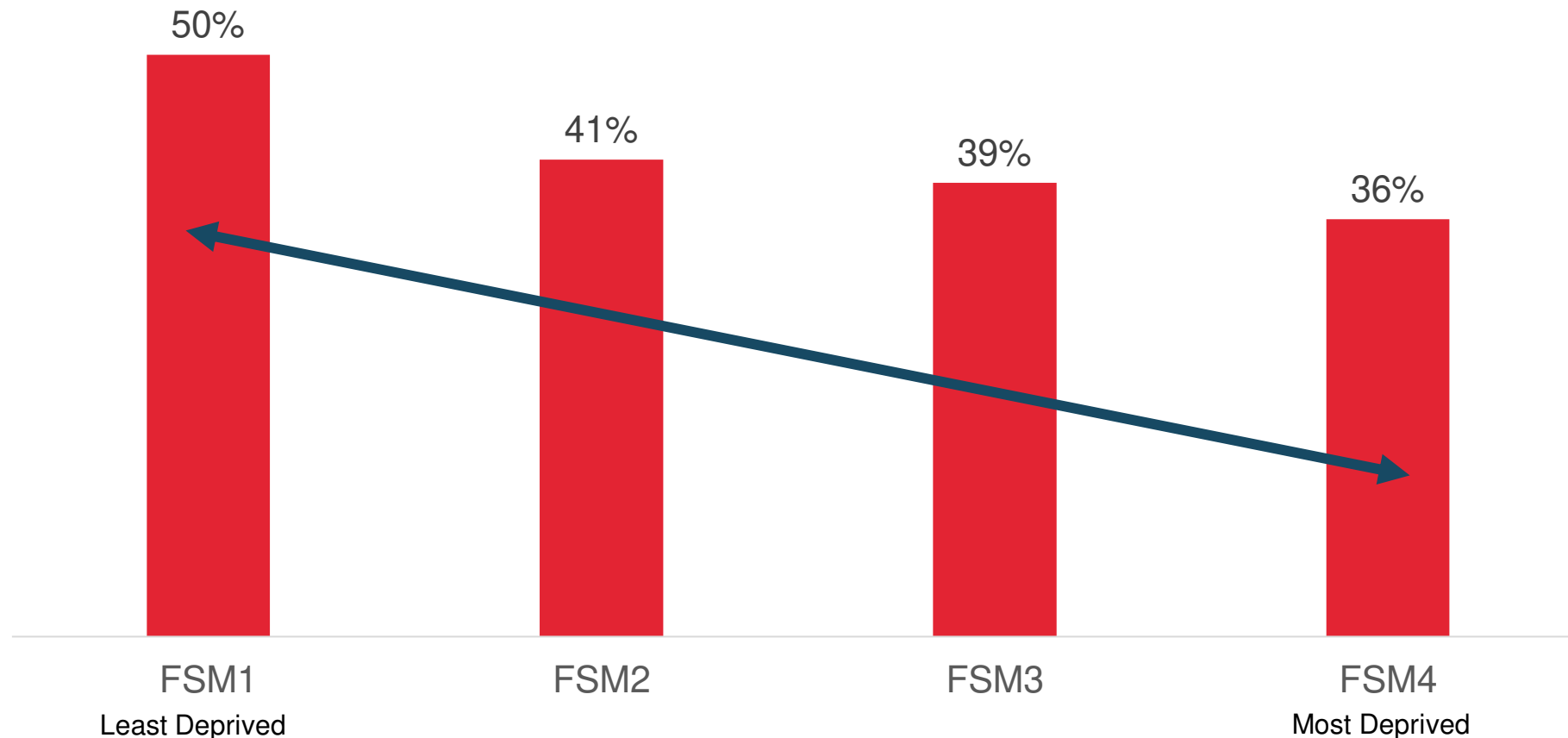

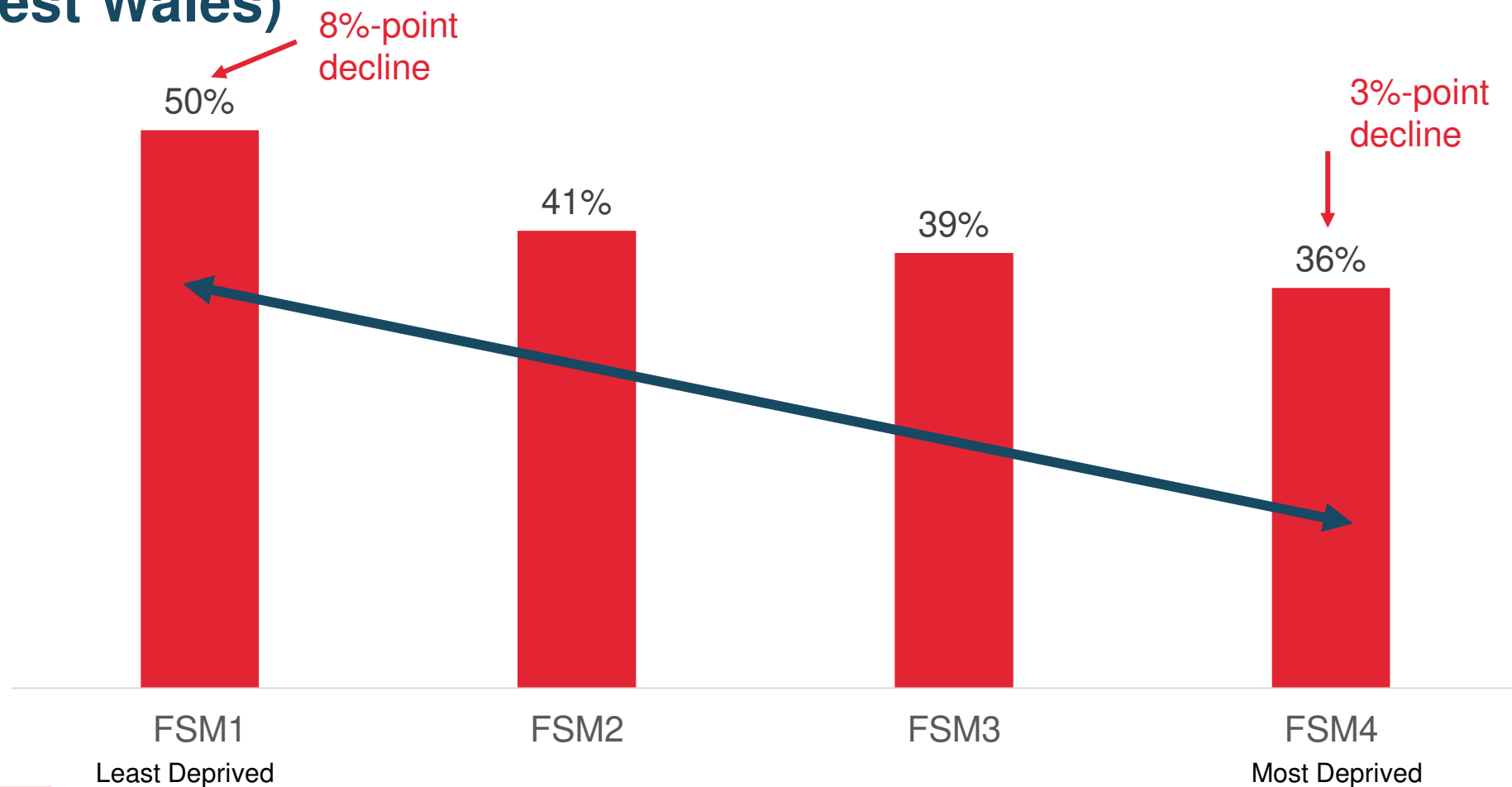

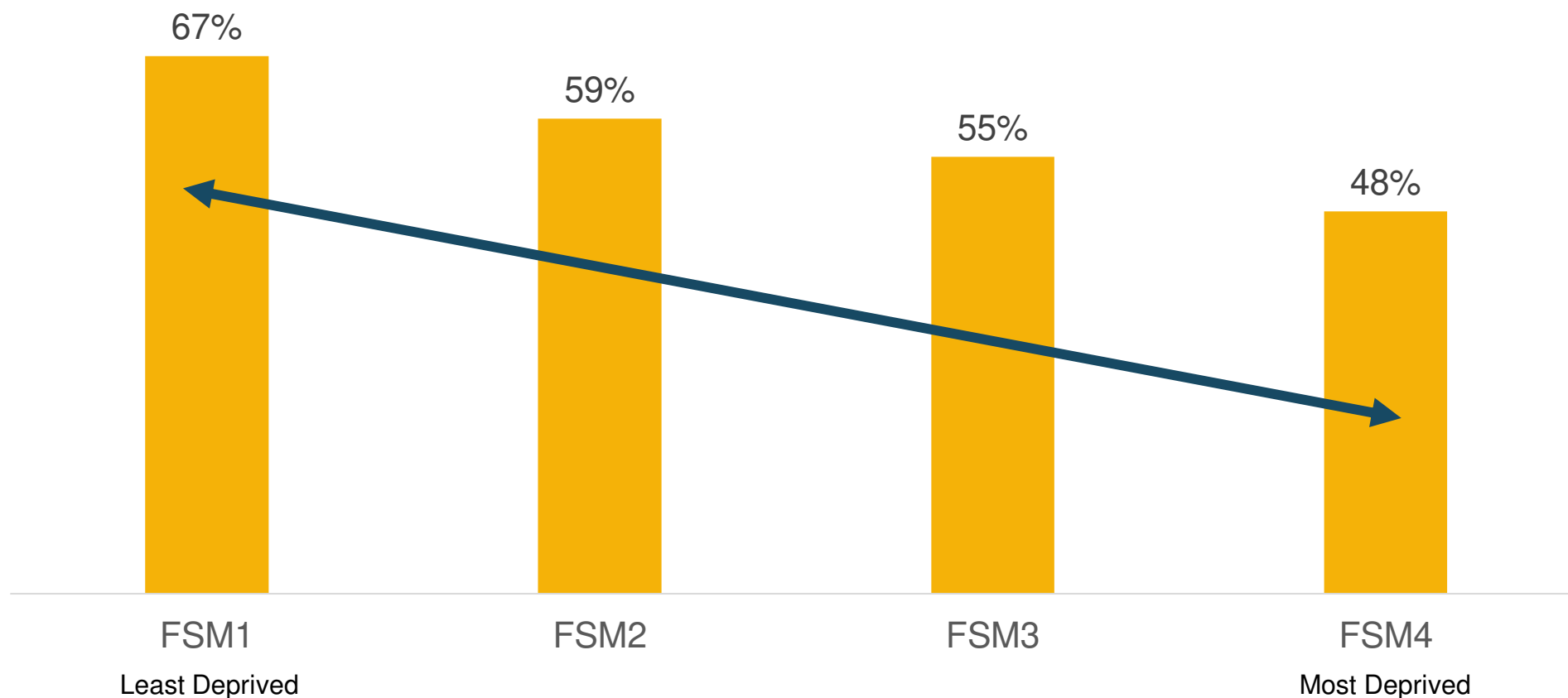

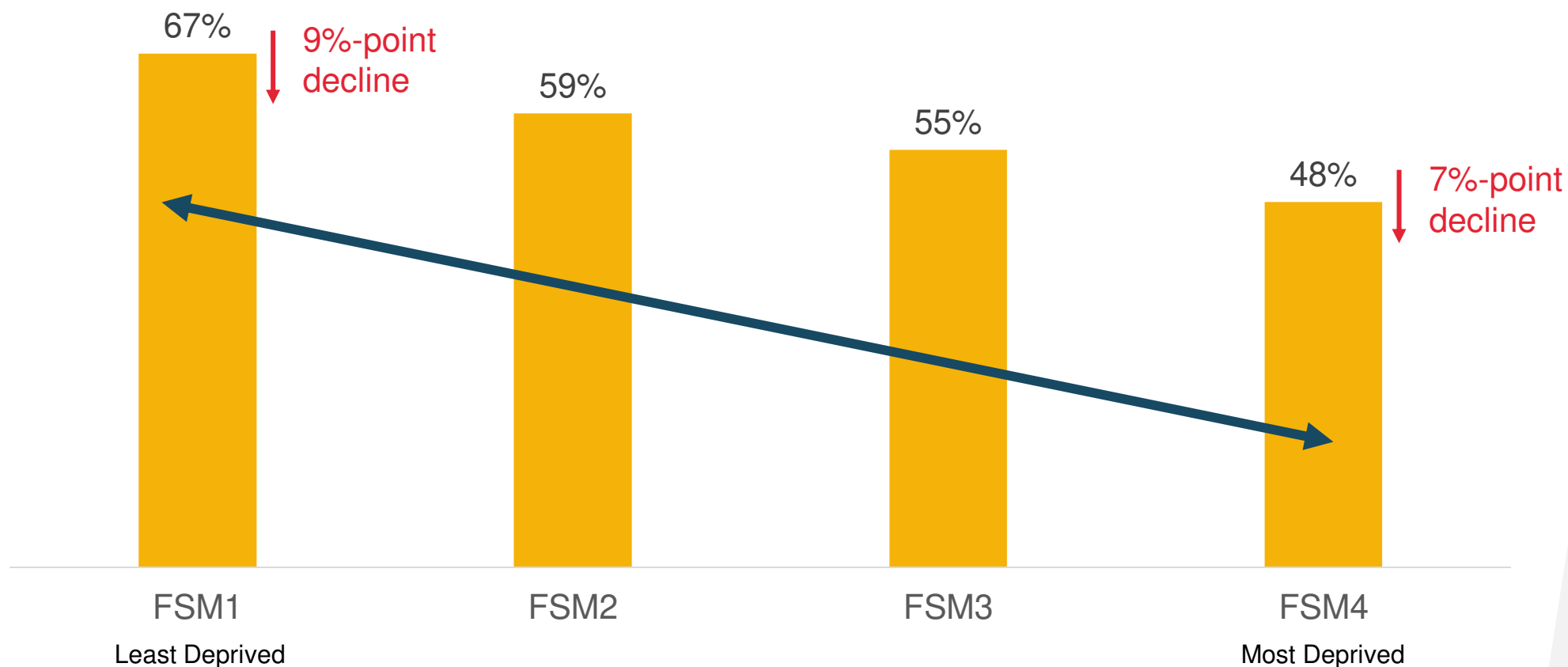

# Deprivation – Frequent Community Club Participation (At least once per week – West Wales)

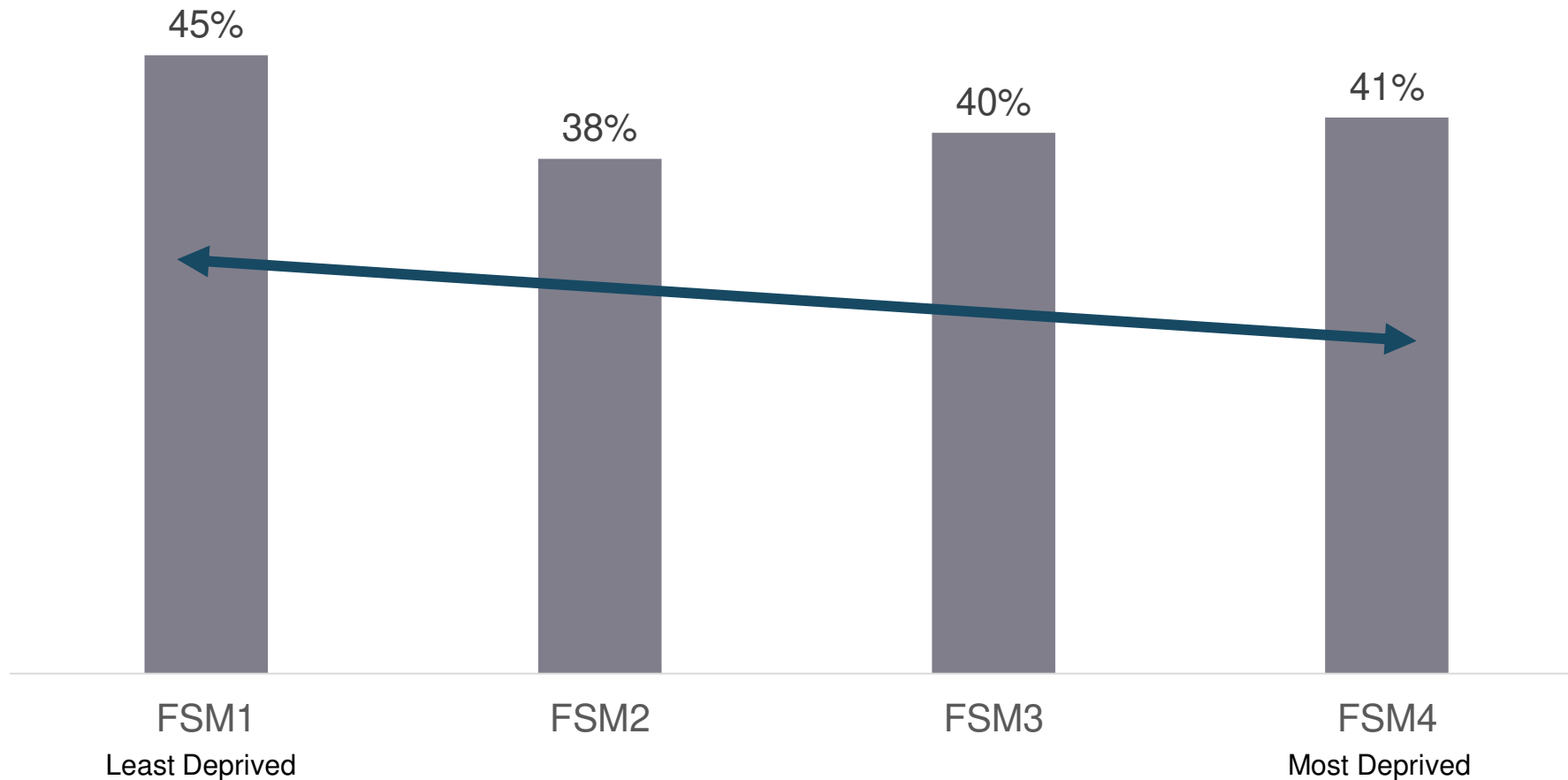

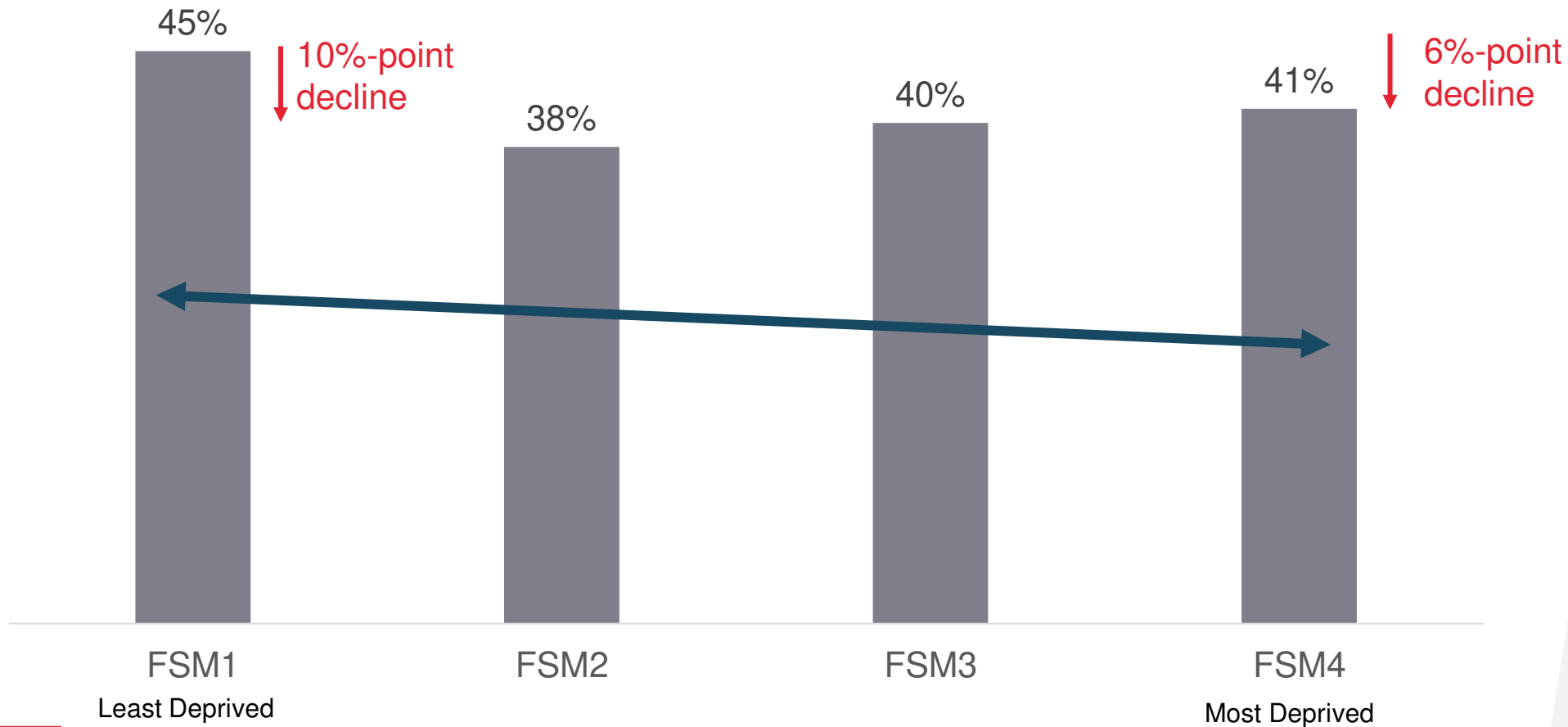


# Deprivation – Frequent Extracurricular Participation (At least once per week – West Wales)

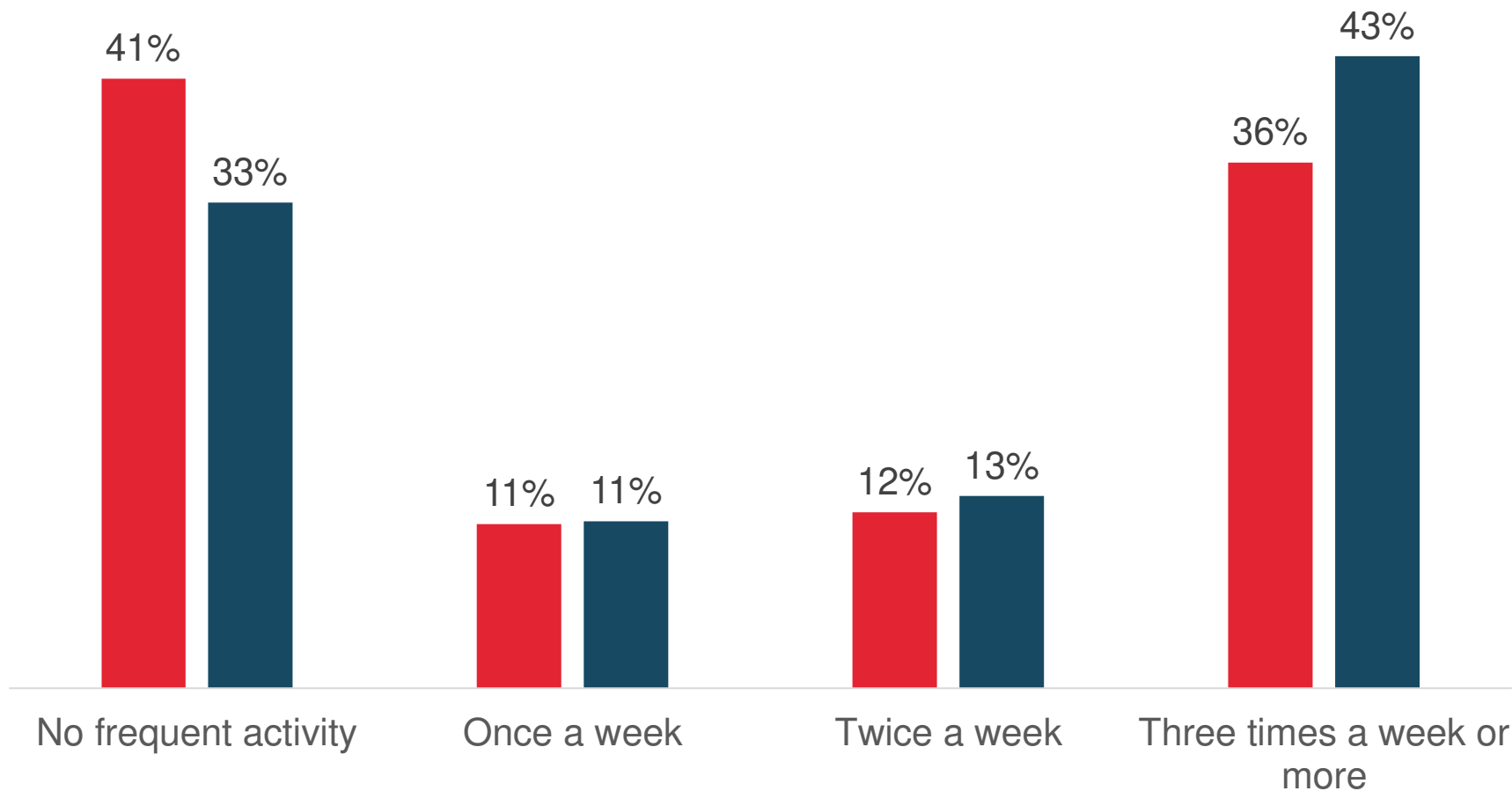

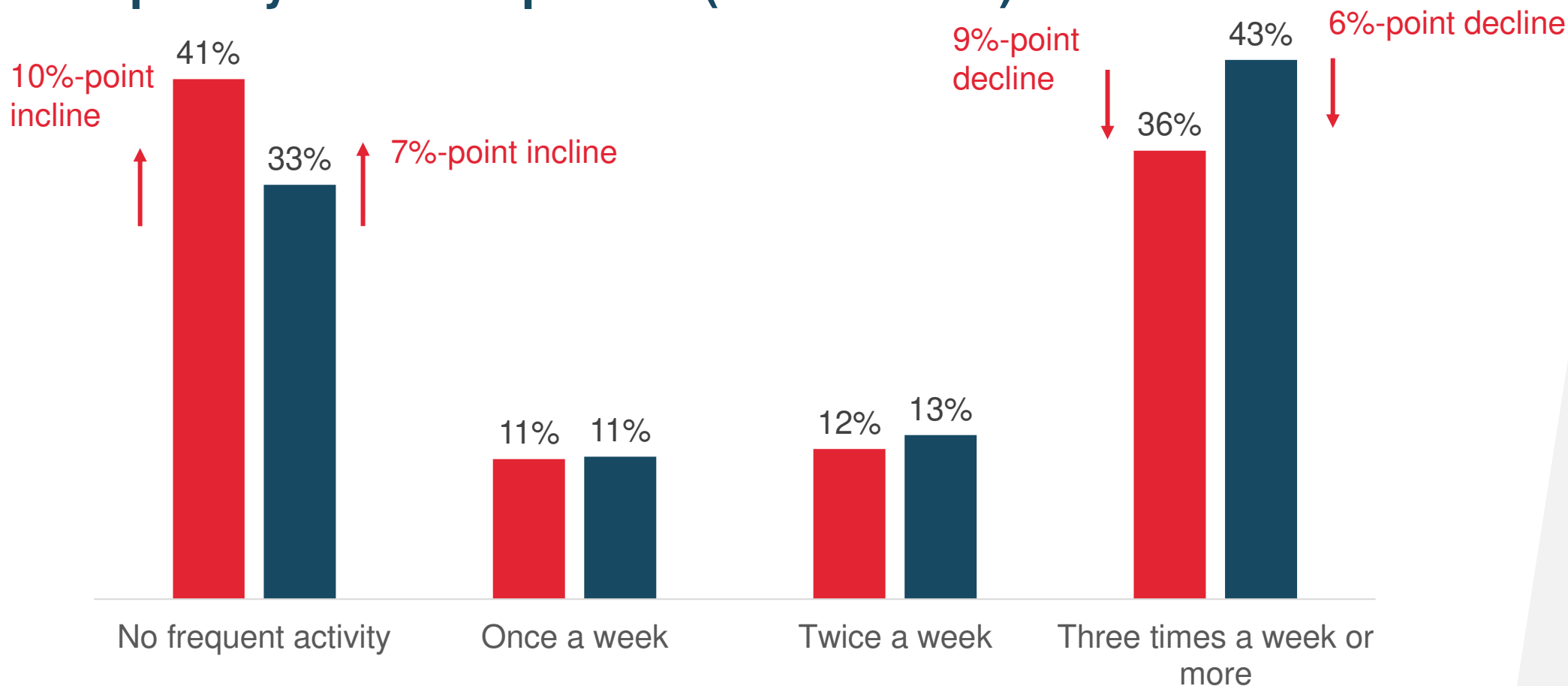

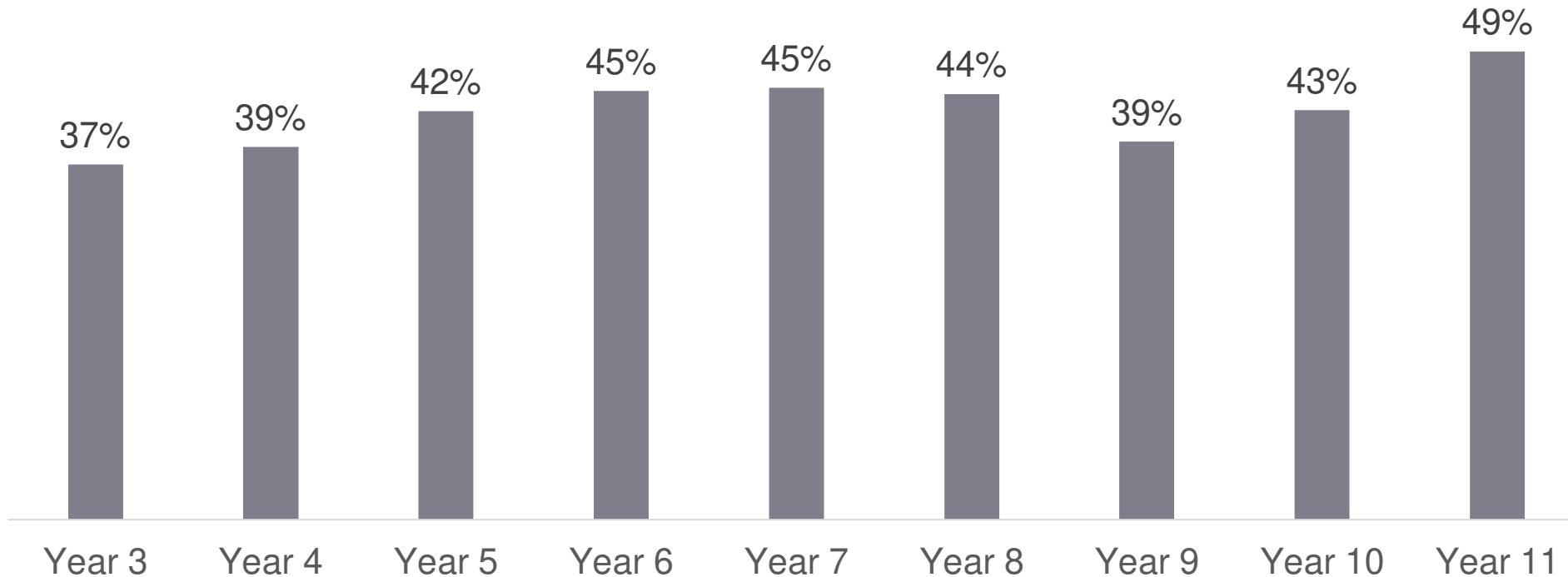

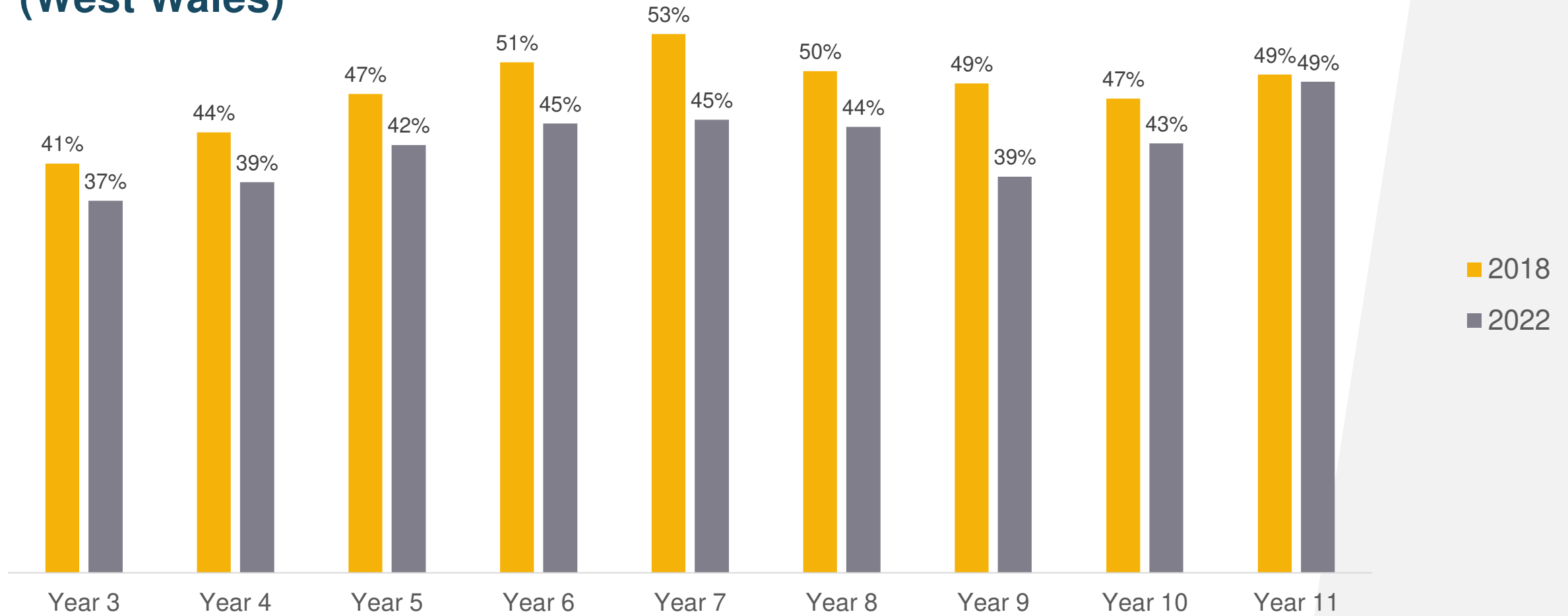

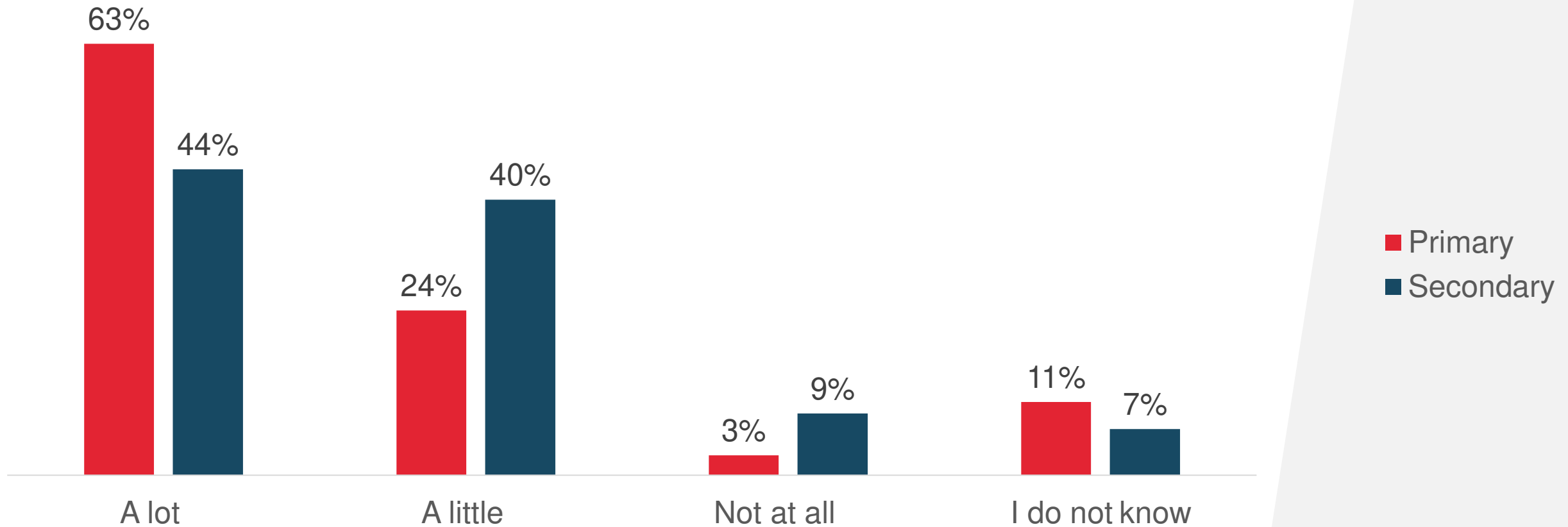
## Participation 3 or more times per week (West Wales)

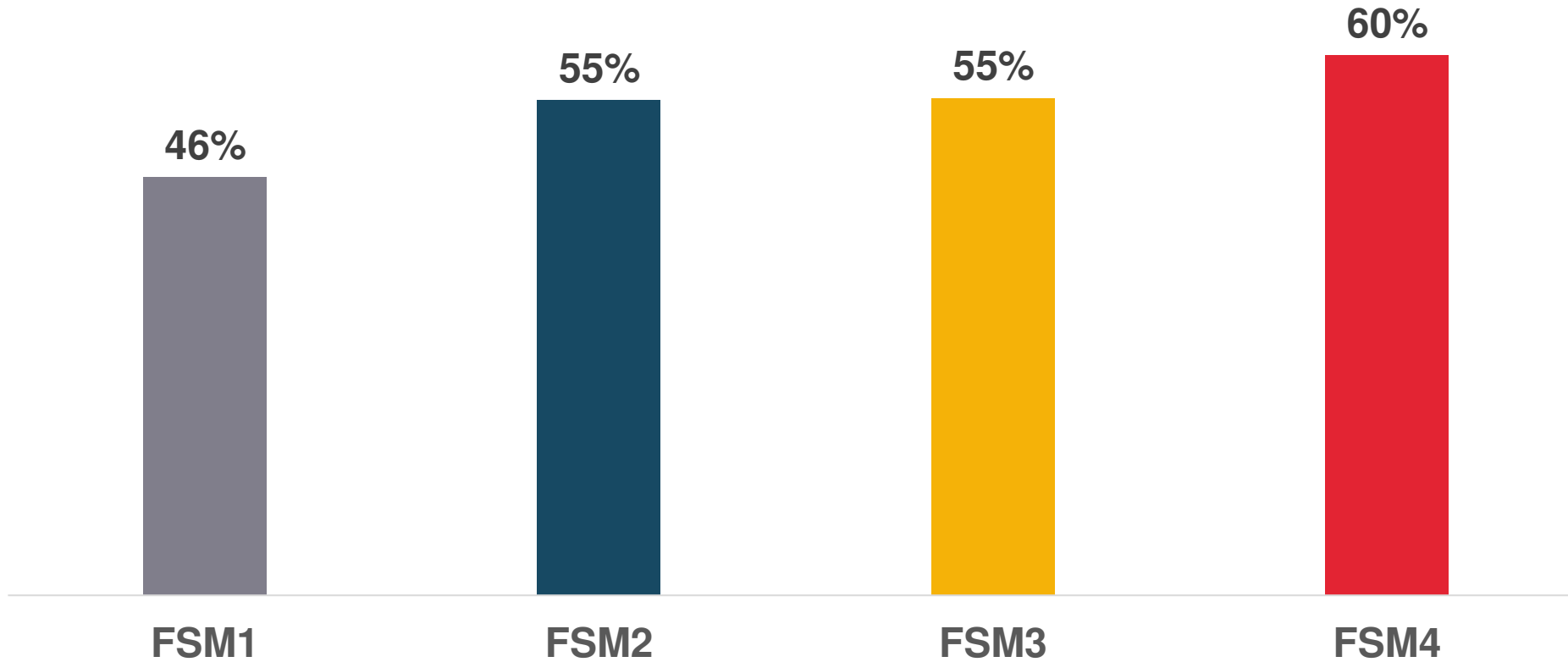

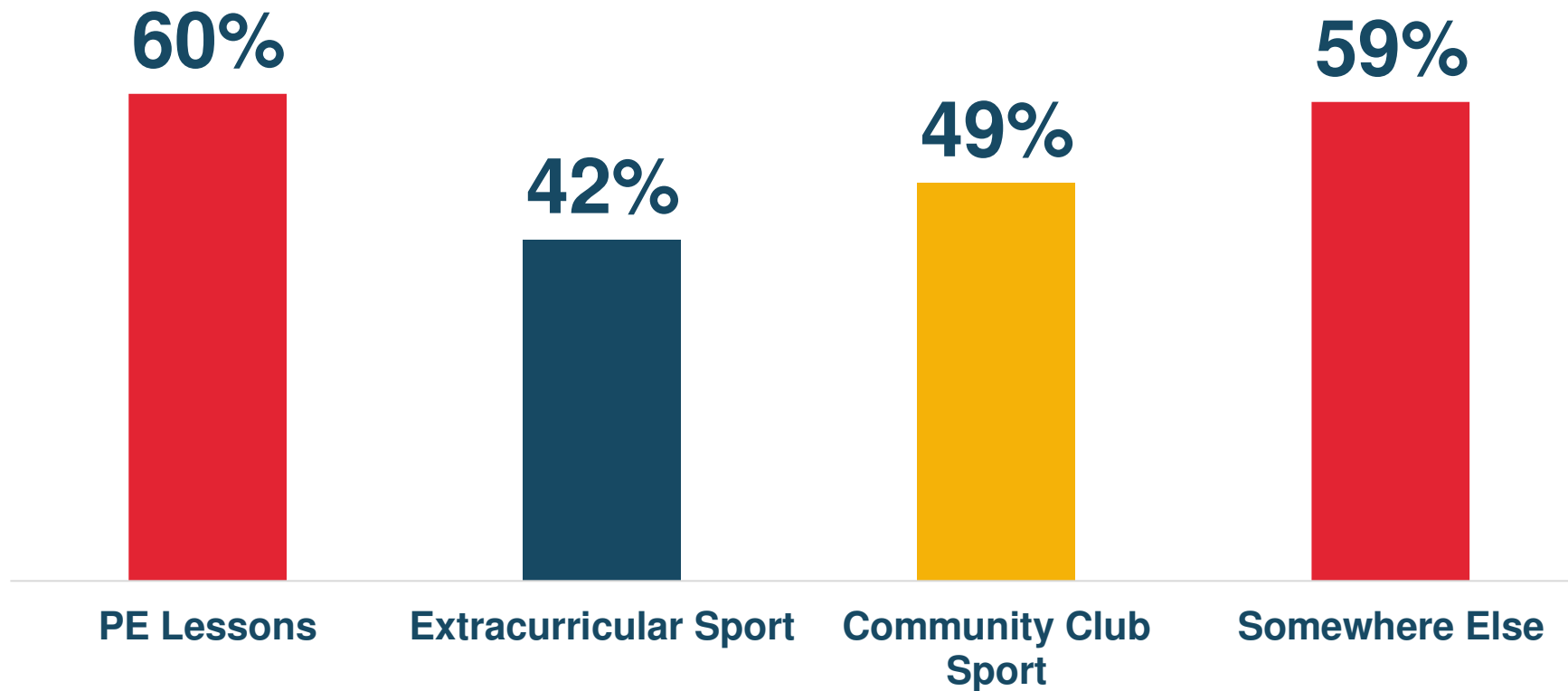

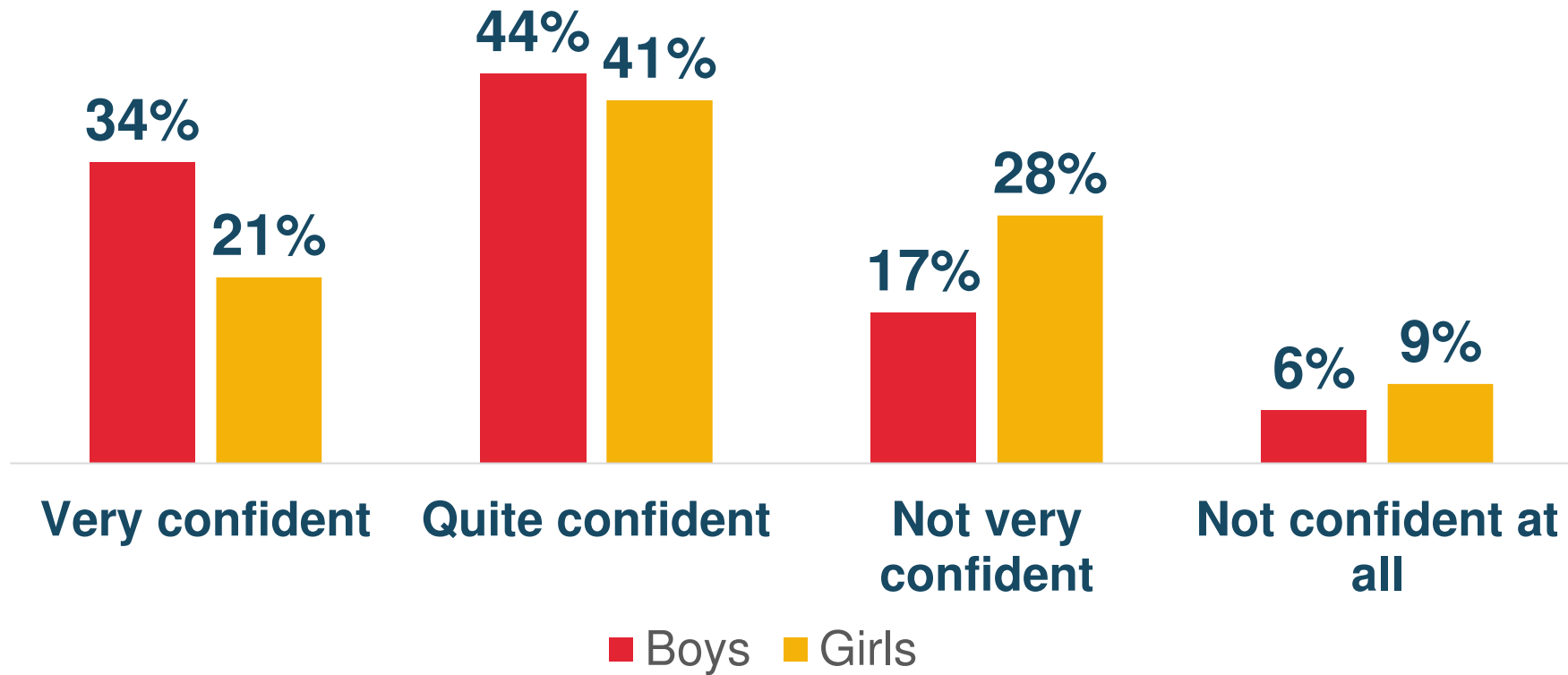
